

Bio: Tom Edwards, *Mr. Reynolds*

Tom attended the University of Calgary, where he started his career performing on the stage. Upon graduation he moved to Vancouver, Canada's "Hollywood North" to gain experience on the screen. He landed the role, Skivver in *Terminal City Ricochet*, starring: Jello Biafra (*The Dead Kennedys* an American hard-core punk band) and Peter Breck, best remembered as the hot-tempered, son Nick in the popular ABC western, *The Big Valley*.

Edwards has acquired continual roles in theatre, television and film. Boasting, a swinging ladies-man in the series, *Mentors* a hockey dad in *Mixed Blessings*, and a desperate, policeman in, *Spooked* starring Eric Roberts from the NBC series, *Fear Itself*; directed by Brad Anderson (*Session 9, The Machinist, The Killing*).

Most Recently, Edwards landed a role in the fourth season of the Gemini award-winning series, *Blackstone*.

His film credits include, *Rock Paper Dice Enter, A Louder Silence, Love/Hate*, and the remake of, *Monte Walsh* starring Tom Selleck and the stunning Isabella Rossellini.

The last time Edwards had a role that required as much range as Mr. Reynolds in *The Last Bastard*, was as Nathan's Last Pick-up in Dave Shultz's *Jet Boy*, with Kelly Rowan.

Some of Tom's cherished theatre roles have included: Mr. Mushnik in, *Little Shop of Horrors*, Barney in, *Last of the Red Hot Lovers*, and Harold Ballard in, *Harold the Bastard*.

Over the last 20 years Tom has been a member of *Die Nasty*; a live soap opera that took home the Comedy Award for *Best Improv Troupe in Canada* – the soap is currently in it's 24th year. Now that's a long stint!
